

On this occasion, students of all three years clean up the hostel and surrounding premises.

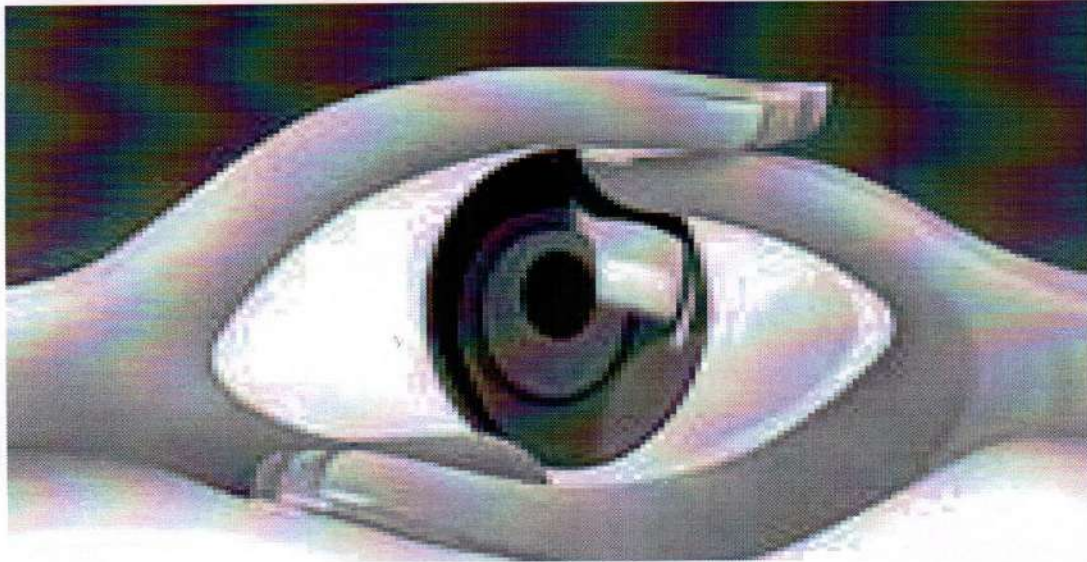
The area of 7th Floor students' hostel cleaned by nursing students from 10 am to 11 am.
